Applicant hereby applies for exhibit space at the Rodeo on the Range™ motorcycle rodeo event produced by Dog Slobber Productions, llc. This application shall become an agreement between applicant and Dog Slobber Productions, llc, for the use of said space under the following terms and conditions.

Dog Slobber Productions, llc, will assign vendor space in accordance with a vendor's stated preference, depending upon its availability. Vendor Fees will include space rental and 2 vendor credentials per vendor agreement. Additional vendor wristbands are available at check-in for a fee. Upon payment, all applicants will receive a confirmation. Location will be assigned upon check-in.

Where appropriate, vendors will be asked to donate one item from their stock towards door prizes and raffles.

Terms and Conditions for Vendor Space

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

- No space will be considered reserved until payment is received. All returned checks will be subject to a \$35 fee.

BOOTH SPACE ASSIGNMENT

- Specific location (booth) assignments will be made upon registration and full payment received.
- In the unlikely event that re-assignment is necessary, Dog Slobber Productions, Inc, will make every effort to work with the vendor, but management decisions are final.
- In the event you do not set up your booth space during the assigned set up time range, Dog Slobber Productions, Inc, reserves the right to re-assign, without consultation or discussion, your booth space.

VENDOR PASSES

- Vendors will receive two wristbands at check in. Employees receiving gratis wrist bands need to be present at check in. Wristbands must be worn at all times and are not transferable.
- Additional vendor staff wristbands may be purchased at a reduced rate in advance or at check in.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Over 120 Days – Full Refund less \$25 processing fee
- 120 – 60 Days – 50% of Exhibit Fee Refunded
- 59 – 0 Days - No Refund

SET-UP/TEARDOWN POLICY

- Set up times will be provided with confirmation of your registration.
- Generally, set up will be available on Friday, May 11 prior to the noon opening time, and Thursday, May 10 by request.
- Semi-trucks and larger 5th wheels must set up on Thursday, May 10.
- ALL vendors must be set up prior to gates opening on Friday, May 11 at noon.
- Teardown may begin when gates close on Sunday, May 13 at 3 pm.
- ALL teardown and removal must be completed by Monday, May 15 at noon.
- Vendors are responsible for the complete removal and cleanup of their booth area. Failure to do so will result in the vendor being billed for cleaning services. Payment methods on file may be used to satisfy the bill.
- NO vendor may begin early tear down without explicit approval by Dog Slobber, Inc. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to this policy. Early tear downs will result in the vendor being billed \$100 Early Tear Down fee, and may result in banning from future events.

BOOTH POLICY

- No spiking or drilling into the ground will be allowed without explicit prior approval of event management.
- No booth or vendor area may have any material, configuration, or condition that may be a hazard to public safety.
- It is the vendor's responsibility to know, understand, and abide by local laws and ordinances regarding vendor booths, tents, materials, etc.

FIRE RESTRICTIONS

- It is the responsibility of the vendor to ensure their booth and area conform to the local laws and ordinances.
- Pertinent requirements for this event may be found at the Rodeo on the Range website or via the City of Tucson.

MERCHANDISE RESTRICTIONS

- No vendor may provide any attraction that could be construed as a "ride."
- No vendor may provide any game of chance.
- No vendor may provide any alcoholic beverage for consumption or removal.
- No vendor may provide, display, license, sell, or merchandise any event related item without the express written permission of Dog Slobber Productions, Inc. This includes, but is not limited to, t-shirts, patches, pins, etc., that contain the event name, date, city, logo, etc.
- Dog Slobber Productions, Inc, reserves the right to reject or approve any product or service offered by vendors at its sole discretion.
- Items that will be rejected include, but are not limited to, any item suspected of copyright or trademark infringement, offensive material, illegal drugs or drug related paraphernalia, firearms, etc.
- Any products or services rejected by Dog Slobber Productions, Inc, must be removed immediately. Failure to comply will result in Dog Slobber Productions, Inc, removing the offending items.
- Any merchandise made to appear as licensed event merchandise will be confiscated and not returned.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- Decisions of Dog Slobber Productions, Inc, are final and not appealable.
- Dog Slobber Productions, Inc, may terminate vendor's registration and admittance for good cause.
- Vendor agrees to abide by all applicable laws.
- Vendor agrees to assume all costs and liability arising from not abiding by applicable laws or rights infringement.
- Vendor agrees to assume all risks arising out of or relating to its attendance or participation at said event and to protect, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Dog Slobber Productions, Inc, Rodeo on the Range™ motorcycle rodeo, its owner, the operator of the event site and facility, and each of their agents, servants, contractors, and employees from any and all liability, loss, damage, or expense it may cause or sustain from any cause whatsoever, including fire, theft, personal injury, public enemy, act of God, strike, misconduct, or property loss.
- Vendor waives and foregoes all claims for damages and recourse of any kind.
- Dog Slobber Productions, Inc, and its assignee(s) or designee(s) shall have the exclusive absolute and unrestricted worldwide right to produce, obtain, copyright, use, assign, sell, reproduce, print and publish in whole or in part any and all photographic, film, audio, or videotaped, written or printed accounts, stories or other materials relating to vendors attendance at this event. Vendor cannot sell, give or offer for sale any pictures or accounting of this event for publication without the permission of Dog Slobber Productions, Inc.
- Vendor may not transfer or assign this agreement.
- Failure to abide by the spirit of the event will result in the vendor and vendor staff being removed from the premises without refund or recourse.
- Security will be provided but items left in the booth area are left at vendors own risk.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

- Applicant agrees to observe and comply with all applicable laws, statues, ordinances, rules and regulations. Applicant assumes all costs and liability arising from the use of patented, trademarked, copyrighted or service marked materials, equipment, processes or creative rights. Applicant shall not assign or attempt to sell or assign this agreement or any rights hereunder without the prior written consent of Dog Slobber Productions, Inc. Dog Slobber Productions, Inc., reserves the right to terminate the license granted by this agreement for good cause and, in said event, Applicant agrees to waive and forego all claims for damages and recourse of any kind. Applicant agrees to assume all risks arising out of or relating to its attendance or participation at said event and to protect, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Dog Slobber Productions, Inc, the owner and the operator of the event site and facility, and each of their agents, servants, contractors, and employees from any and all liability, loss, damage or expense it may cause or sustain from any cause whatsoever, including fire, theft, personal injury or property loss. I further acknowledge that I am aware that I cannot sell, give or offer for sale any pictures or accounting of this event for publication without the permission of Dog Slobber Productions, Inc.
